OLA Rules

Compliance with Ordinance 031009-09 & PARD Policy

Dogs Must:

- Be on-leash when entering & leaving the OLAs
- Wear a collar or harness at all times
- Display tags showing proof of current & complete cycle of vaccinations
- Play well with others at all times
- Respond to voice command by owner/guardian
- Stay within OLA boundaries if un-leashed
- Not be in heat
- Woof, woof, bark, grrr!

Owners/Guardians Must:

- Pick up and dispose your pet's waste in the appropriate trash cans/receptacle
- Always be prepared with pet waste bags on hand
- Always carry a leash for each dog in your care
- Have voice control over your dog
- Accept responsibility for any damage or injury caused by your dog
- Immediately remove your dog when behaving badly
- Remain in the OLA to supervise your dog
- Limit 4 dogs per owner/guardian
- Closely supervise young children
- Play well with others at all times
- Be respectful of other visitors
- Comply with all other park rules
- Leash all dogs when PARD staff services OLA



All OLAs are subject to regular closures for routine maintenance as well as longer term closures for restoration as needed. OLA users are expected to adhere to the leash law when the OLA is not available.

The City of Austin's Animal Control officers have the authority to enforce restraint and pet waste laws.

Violators are subject to fines up to \$500.
