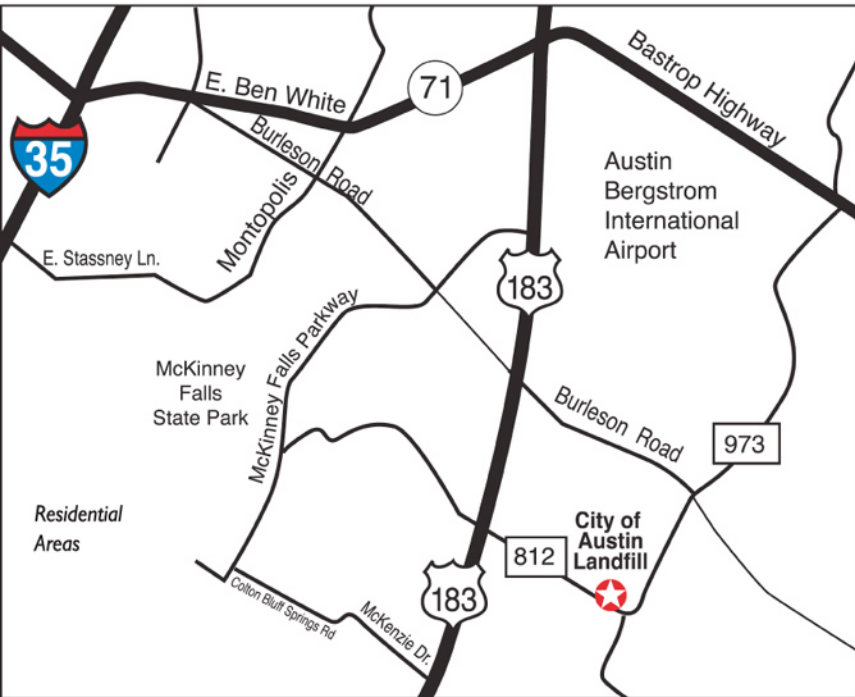

Landfill & Diversion Center



The City of Austin Landfill can accept the following materials: paper, shredded tires, whole tires, brush, rags, cartons, woods, furniture, rubber, plastics, glass, concrete, rocks, dirt and similar materials. Rates are set by the Austin City Council each year.

The Diversion Center, located on the landfill grounds, can accept items such as appliances, car batteries, aluminum cans and large metal items.

The Diversion Center no longer accepts computer monitors, microwaves, TV's or used motor oil.

Due to the proximity of the airport, the City of Austin Landfill cannot accept putrescible waste, such as garbage, grease trap waste, food, household sanitary waste, household trash, or any waste that will cause odors or gases and may attract or provide food for birds or animals. Other landfills in the area may be able to accept this type of waste.

The City of Austin Landfill and Diversion Center are at 10108 FM 812.

From central Austin, go south on 183 towards Lockhart.

Go straight through the light at Burleson Road.

Turn left at the next light at FM 812.

The landfill is the second landfill on your left, about 1 mile down the road.

OR

From Bastrop, go west on Highway 71.

Before passing the airport, turn left on to FM 973.

Take FM 973 to the stop sign at FM 812.

Turn right on to FM 812. The landfill will be the first one on your right.
